PASTORAL COUNCIL MINUTES for Tuesday, June 20, 2017

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1) Parish Picture Directory: There will be an opportunity for people to sign-up after Mass for a few more weekends. People can also sign-up online during the week. We are still looking for volunteers to help with the sign-ups after weekend Masses and also to help with the sign-ins the week of the photography.
